- 1. Always use your grill outside and away from the house
- 2. Open the lid before igniting
- 3. Never leave your grill unattended
- **4.** Clear a 3-foot area around the grill and place it away from heavily trafficked areas, especially where children play
- 5. Keep your grill clean and remove grease build-ups
- 6. Always place cooled coals in a metal, lidded container
