How Does Freelancing Work?

A freelancing work can be divided into four stages, following are them:

1. **Getting clients:** The first step of freelancing is finding clients willing to hire or work with a freelancer. Some popular websites and apps freelancers use for finding clients are Upwork, Fiverr, and LinkedIn.
2. **Agreement/Contract:** Before starting, a freelancer and a client need to set an agreement. Here you will discuss your pay and the work you have to do. For example, a freelancer video editor will get \$50 for each 5-minute video editing.
3. **Starting work:** Your contract has begun, and you have to submit the work within the given deadlines. For example, 10 videos were edited in this month.
4. **Getting paid:** You will get paid as per the agreement. For example, 10 edited videos will get you \$500, and like this, you can work with multiple clients as well.
